**ORDER GRANTING JOINT MOTION FOR EXTENSION
OF TIME TO FILE INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT**

On February 25, 2009¹, the Commission ordered Charter Fiberlink-Missouri, LLC and CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC, to file an interconnection agreement that conforms to the Commission's Order Adopting Final Arbitrator's Report. The Commission ordered the parties to file such an agreement no later than March 4.

On February 26, the parties filed a Joint Motion for Extension of Time to File Interconnection Agreement. The parties stated that they are creating a conforming agreement, but that they will be unable to complete the agreement by March 4. The parties stated they would be able to file a final agreement no later than March 27, and therefore ask the Commission to extend their deadline to that date.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) allows parties ten days to respond to pleadings. However, because the March 4 deadline will arrive before ten days after February 26, and because the parties filed a joint motion, the Commission will dispense with the ten-day waiting period, and will rule upon the motion expeditiously.

The Commission finds the motion reasonable, and will grant it.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Joint Motion for Extension of Time to File Interconnection Agreement filed by Charter Fiberlink-Missouri, LLC and CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC, is granted.
2. The parties shall file a conforming interconnection agreement no later than March 27, 2009.
3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
