On July 10, 2012, YMax Communications Corp. ("YMax") filed tariff revisions, later substituted on July 31.¹ On August 3, AT&T Communications of the Southwest, Inc., ("AT&T Communications") and Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri ("AT&T Missouri") filed a Motion to Suspend and Investigate Tariff. The Commission granted the motion to suspend on August 8, and set a prehearing conference for September 11.

On September 10, AT&T Communications and AT&T Missouri withdrew its objection to YMax's tariff, as substituted on September 10. Thus, the Commission will cancel the prehearing conference.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The prehearing conference is canceled.

2. The parties are no longer required to file a proposed procedural schedule
