On behalf of Vyve Broadband A, LLC (formerly known as BCI Allegiance, LLC and hereinafter "Vyve") and in accordance with Section 67.2685, RSMo 2000 (Cum. Supp. 2012), this letter shall serve a written notification to the Public Service Commission of the State of Missouri of Vyve's decision to shut down its operations in Rushville, Missouri and, effective as of August 1, 2015, cease providing video service under its Video Service Authorization (File No. KA-2013-0489). Vyve has determined that continued operations in the political subdivision of Rushville, Missouri are no longer economically feasible. Accordingly, Vyve's Video Service Authorization, which was granted to Vyve by the Public Service Commission of the State of Missouri on May 30, 2013, will terminate on August 1, 2015 and, as of such date, Vyve shall have no further obligations thereunder.
