ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

Issue Date October 28, 2008

This order directs Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers to show cause as to why it has not filed a Position Statement and why it should not be dismissed as a party as a result

thereof.

On June 30, 2008, the Commission issued its Order Adopting Procedural Schedule. In that order, the Commission directed the parties to file a Position Statement on October 23, 2008. With the exception of Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers¹, all parties have filed a Position Statement.

Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(3) states that a party may be dismissed from a case for failure to comply with any order issued by the Commission. The Commission will require that MIEC file a pleading showing good cause for having not filed a Position Statement and why it should not be dismissed as a party.
