ORDER SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

Greater Jefferson City Construction Company, LLC and Edward P. Storey filed a complaint against Aqua Missouri, Inc. Although Aqua Missouri proposed to resolve the complaint by mediation, Complainants declined to do so. Aqua Missouri has answered the complaint and, to move the matter toward resolution, the Commission will set a prehearing conference.

At the prehearing conference, the parties or their representatives should be prepared to discuss the nature of any discovery each will conduct and the interval necessary for its completion; the number of witnesses each expects to call at hearing; the number and nature of any exhibits each expects to offer at hearing; and the anticipated length of the hearing. The parties or their representatives should also be prepared to discuss the current status of settlement negotiations. It is expected that the prehearing

conference will provide an opportunity for the parties to further pursue settlement discussions.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. A prehearing conference shall be held on June 11, 2007 beginning at 10:00 a.m., in Room 305 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. This hearing will be held in a building that meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act.
