On October 24, 2007, the Staff of the Commission filed a motion asking the Commission to extend the time allowed for the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule regarding Staff's complaint against Universal Utilities, Inc. and Nancy Croasdell. Staff explained that the scope of the complaint would be uncertain until the Commission ruled on Staff's request for leave to file an amended complaint and a related motion to compel discovery. On October 25, the Commission suspended the requirement that the parties file a proposed procedural schedule until after the Commission ruled on Staff's motions.
