# **DIFFERENCES**:

Water 14.50 - 4.80	Charged \$9.80 more than the actual cost
Sewer 7.94 – 1.09	Charged \$6.85 more than the actual cost.

 $9.80+6.85 = $16.65 \times 12 = $199.88$  annually

## Closing comments -

- 1. The cost for the meters plus installation has long been recovered and Universal Utilities has absolutely nothing to do with the sewer so their only cost now is for reading the water meters and calculating and sending the statements.
- 2. There is currently a \$5.79 service charge per tenant per month which on a 100 tenant average comes to \$579 per month and \$6948 per year.
- 3. I would be happy to take this gig. I calculate that after the initial time spent in setting up a program I can perform the complete task in one day and that postcards, labels and ink, etc. will cost no more than \$40 per month. \$579 \$40 leaves \$539 for labor. \$539 x 12 = \$6468 profit per year.

francisco de Sala Transportação de Sala Section 22-266 Computation of sewer charges and fees to users outside city.

Each user of the wastewater system of the city whose property or premises may be located outside the corporate limits of such city and within any unincorporated area, shall pay as a sewage service charge a sum equal to the charge computed under the provisions of section 22-263 of this Code plus fifty (50) per cent. Each user of the wastewater system of the city whose property or premises may be located outside the corporate limits of the city and within the corporate limits of any other municipality, or each user in an area whose inhabitants have instituted proceedings for incorporation as another municipality, shall pay as a sewage service charge a sum equal to the charge computed under the provisions of section 22-263 of this Code plus one hundred (100) per cent. Persons owing a connection fee for property located outside the corporate limits of the city shall pay as a connection fee a sum equal to the connection fee computed under the provisions of section 22-264 of this Code plus fifty (50) per cent. The amounts computed in accordance with this section shall be considered as additional capital charges.

# Section 22-263 Charges for sewage service.

- (a) There is hereby levied on each wastewater system user having any sewer connection with the wastewater system of the city or otherwise discharging sewage, industrial waste, or other liquids, either directly or indirectly into the city's wastewater system, a sewage service charge. Subject to the exceptions provided in this article, such charge shall be based upon the quantity of water used in or on the premises as the same is measured by a water or sewer meter or sewer meters approved by the city; provided, however, that if actual sewer service cannot reasonably be determined from the water or sewage so metered, whether due to defect, tampering or causes unknown, the amount of sewage, waste or waters discharged into such system shall be estimated and billed as provided for in section 27-19. Additional charges for extra strength sewage, toxic pollutants, and wastewater monitoring will be levied where applicable.
- (b) The monthly charges for residential and public authority customer classifications shall be based on the average monthly billing of water usage during the immediate preceding calendar months of January, February and March. Where such basis is not considered representative of sewage discharge for public authority customers, the provisions of section 27-19 of this Code or any other reasonable basis of estimating sewage discharge from such customers may be used. Commercial and industrial charges shall be based on one hundred (100) per cent of the monthly metered water used, except as otherwise provided in this Code.
- (1) Basic sewage service charge. Each user of the wastewater system of the city shall pay for the use of such system monthly sewage service charges based on the following rates:

NA — (2) Extra strength charge. Wastewater discharged to the wastewater system from commercial or industrial users shall be subject to an extra strength charge when the BOD or total suspended solids concentration exceeds three hundred (300) milligrams per liter (mg/l) by weight. All analyses shall be performed on composite samples collected at no less than hourly intervals over a twenty-four-hour period.

Extra strength charges shall be calculated based on one hundred (100) per cent of metered water use, except as otherwise provided in section 22-269 of this Code, in accordance with the following formula:

Mr- (3) Monitoring charge. When regulations as set forth by the federal government, state and

city require monitoring of the waste from a commercial or industrial user, whether for strength calculations or for NPDES compliance, that user shall pay a monitoring charge.

The monitoring charge shall consist of all costs for personnel, material and equipment used to collect and analyze samples from the user's wastewater.

The exact charge shall be based on actual costs and shall be determined by the director.

- (4) Toxic pollutant charge. Any user which discharges any toxic pollutants which cause an increase in the cost of managing the effluent or sludge from the city's treatment system shall pay for such increased costs.
  - (5) Base charge. When residential property is vacant and the customer has requested discontinuance of a metered service the customer shall be charged a base charge of four dollars and sixty-one cents (\$ 4.61) per month in lieu of all other charges for sewage services.
