13	A. My name is Matthew J. Barnes and my business address is Missouri Public

15	Q. What is your position with the Missouri Public Service Commission
16	(Commission)?
17	A. I am a Utility Regulatory Auditor IV in the Energy Resource Analysis Section
18	of the Energy Department of the Utility Operations Division.
19	Q. Are you the same Matthew J. Barnes that filed rebuttal testimony on April 18,
20	2011, and surrebuttal testimony on April 28, 2011, and contributed to the Staff's Revenue
21	Requirement Cost of Service Report filed on February 23, 2011 and the Staff's Rate Design
22	Class Cost of Service Report filed on March 16, 2011?
23	A. Yes, I am.
24	Q. What is the purpose of your true-up direct testimony?
25	A. The purpose of my true-up direct testimony is to provide a true-up for known
26	and measurable changes through March 31, 2011 for The Empire District Electric Company's
27	(Empire or Company) base fuel and purchased power costs plus air quality control systems
28	costs (AQCS) and less renewable energy credits (REC) revenue. My recommendation
29	contained in this true-up testimony will include the costs and the benefits of the Southern Star

Central Pipeline natural gas storage contract in the Company's Fuel Adjustment Clause
 (FAC). My true-up direct testimony will also provide a true-up for the FAC base cost per
 kWh.

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Staff's True-Up FAC Base Fuel and Purchased Power Costs Per kWh

- Q. Did Staff true-up its estimate of fuel and purchased power costs plus AQCS
 costs and less REC revenue for known and measurable changes through March 31, 2011?
 - A. Yes.
- 8 Q. Would you please summarize Staff's recommendation for true-up for Empire's
 9 FAC base fuel and purchased power costs plus AQCS costs and less REC revenue?
- A. Staff's true-up for Empire's FAC base fuel and purchased power costs plus
 AQCS costs and less REC revenue includes the following: 1) true-up loads; 2) true-up fuel
 and purchased power costs and AQCS costs; and 3) true-up REC revenue.

- Q. What is the benefit of natural gas storage?

A. Empire entered into a natural gas storage contract signed June 17, 2010 for the term of April 1, 2011 until April 1, 2016. This will allow the Company to purchase and store natural gas in the summer to use in the winter. Staff witness Daniel I. Beck provides true-up direct testimony that describes Empire's natural gas storage contract in more detail, and Staff's proposed ratemaking treatment of the costs and benefits associated with this contract in this case.

- 20 Q. What FAC base cost per kWh did Staff recommend in its rebuttal testimony?
- A. Staff recommended a base cost of \$0.02706 per kWh.
- 22 Q. What FAC base cost per kWh is Staff recommending for true-up?
- A. Staff recommends a base cost of \$0.02918 per kWh.
- Q. What caused the increase in the base cost per kWh?

A. The increase in the base cost per kWh was caused by an increase in fuel and
 purchased power prices.

3 **<u>Recommendation</u>**

Q. What does the Commission need to include in its Report and Order to
effectuate Staff's recommendation for Empire's FAC?

A. The Commission needs to include in its Report and Order to effectuate Staff's
recommendation for Empire's FAC, a sharing mechanism of 85%/15% and a true-up base
fuel and purchased power costs plus AQCS costs less REC revenue of \$0.02918 per kWh
based on Staff's fuel model run updated for known and measurable changes through March
31, 2011.
