On April 13, 2007, Trinsic Communications, Inc., Touch 1 Communications, Inc., and Matrix Telecom, Inc., filed a joint application with the Commission for the transfer of control of Trinsic's assets used to provide local and long distance telecommunications services to Matrix. Simultaneously with the application, Trinsic and Matrix filed a Motion for Expedited Treatment.

The applicants state that Trinsic and its affiliates have filed a petition for relief under Chapter 11 of the United States Bankruptcy Code in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of Alabama. Pursuant to a court-approved auction, the applicants have entered into an agreement for sale of the assets to Matrix. The agreement requires that the transactions be complete on or before June 4, 2007. Thus, the applicants request that the Commission's decision be effective no later than that date.

The Commission will direct that any interested party may intervene in this matter no later than the date set out below. In addition, the Commission shall establish a date for any response to the Motion for Expedited Treatment to be filed. Finally, the Commission will be aided by a recommendation from its Staff. The Commission will direct its Staff to file a recommendation as set out below.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. That any proper person wishing to intervene in this matter shall file a request to do so no later than April 23, 2007.

2. That any response to the Motion for Expedited Treatment shall be filed no later than April 23, 2007.

3. That the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file its recommendation, or a status report indicating the earliest date on which it expects to file its recommendation, no later than May 14, 2007.

4. This order shall become effective on April 17, 2007.
