ORDER GRANTING PETITION FOR ADMISSION *PRO HAC VICE*

This order grants the petition for leave to appear *pro hac vice* of Paul M. Schudel, James A. Overcash and Thomas J. Moorman on behalf of CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC (hereafter "CenturyTel").

On August 18, 2008, Messrs. Schudel, Overcash and Moorman filed a Petition for Admission *Pro Hac Vice*. The petition states that Mr. Schudel is licensed to practice law in the State of Nebraska and in several federal circuits, that Mr. Overcash is licensed to practice law in the State of Nebraska and several federal circuits, and that Mr. Moorman is licensed to practice in The District of Columbia, The District of Columbia Court of Appeals and the U.S. Court of Appeals D.C. Circuit. Further, it states Larry Dority, a member of The Missouri Bar, would be local counsel. The application further contains proof of compliance with Missouri Supreme Court Rule 6.01(m).

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) allows parties ten days to respond to motions. No party responded. Therefore, the Commission will take up the application unopposed.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.040(3)(C) lists the standard for appearing before the Commission *pro hac vice*. The Commission finds that the petitioners have complied with that rule and with Missouri Supreme Court Rule 6.01(m). Therefore, the Commission will grant the petition.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Petition for Admission *Pro Hac Vice* of Paul M. Schudel, James A. Overcash and Thomas J. Moorman is granted.
2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
