ORDER SUSPENDING TARIFF AND SCHEDULING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On July 10, 2012, YMax Communications Corp. filed tariff revisions, later substituted on July 31.¹ The tariff sheets bear an effective date of August 10.

On August 3, AT&T Communications of the Southwest, Inc., ("AT&T Communications") and Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri ("AT&T Missouri") filed a Motion to Suspend and Investigate Tariff. According to AT&T Communications and AT&T Missouri, the proposed tariff could allow YMax to charge other carriers for access functions that are expressly prohibited by FCC order.

Staff replied on August 7, asking the Commission to suspend the tariffs for 60 days. YMax did not respond.

To allow sufficient time to study the effect of the proposed tariffs and establish an evidentiary record, the proposed tariffs will be suspended. The Commission will also schedule a prehearing conference to afford the parties the opportunity to discuss, define, and possibly resolve the issues presented. The Commission will also set a date for the filing of a proposed procedural schedule to ensure that this case progresses.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The proposed tariff sheets submitted on July 10, 2012, by YMax

Communications Corp. and assigned Tariff No. JC-2013-0026, are suspended for a

period of 60 days beyond August 10, 2012, to October 9, 2012, or until otherwise

ordered by this Commission.

A prehearing conference shall be held on August 22, 2012, at 10:00 a.m.,

in Room 305 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City,

Missouri, a building that meets accessibility standards of the Americans with Disabilities

Act. Any person who needs specific accessibility accommodations may call the Public

to the hearing.

3. The parties shall file a proposed procedural schedule no later than

August 29, 2012. The procedural schedule shall include dates for the filing of testimony

and for a hearing.

4. That this order shall become effective immediately on issuance.
