STAFF RECOMMENDATION TO APPROVE TARIFF FILING

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff), through the undersigned counsel, to recommend that the Missouri Commission approve the proposed tariff revisions included in the tariff filing JC-2013-0026, and respectfully states the following:

1. On July 10, 2012, YMax Communications Corp. ("YMax") filed tariff revisions, later substituted on July 31 and again on September 9. AT&T Communications of the Southwest, Inc., ("AT&T Communications") and Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri ("AT&T Missouri"), and Verizon Business Services ("Verizon"), intervenors, withdrew their previous objections to the tariff. The current effective date of the tariff is October 23, 2013.

2. Having reviewed the filing, as described in the attached Memorandum, the Staff now recommends that the tariff filing be approved by the Commission at the earliest possible date.

WHEREFORE, the Staff respectfully requests that the Commission approve the tariff filing referred to as JC-2013-0026.

On July 10, 2012 YMax Communications Corporation (YMax) filed tariff sheets to implement revisions to its intrastate switched access Missouri PSC Tariff No. 2. YMax's revisions were made pursuant to changes mandated by the Federal Communications Commission.

YMax's revisions were objected to by AT&T Missouri (AT&T) and Verizon Business Services (Verizon). On July 31st and September 9th YMax filed substitute tariff sheets to its July 10th filing. After discussions among the parties, on September 10, 2012, AT&T and Verizon withdrew previous objections. On October 2nd, the Commission issued an order granting YMax's request to extend the filing's effective date until October 23, 2012.

The Telecommunications Staff (Staff) has reviewed YMax's proposed tariff sheets and recommends they be approved by the Commission at its earliest convenience. Alternatively, the Staff recommends the tariff sheets be permitted to go into effect by operation of law on October 23, 2012. The Staff is unaware of any other matter that affects this matter.
