On March 17, 2006, NuVox Communications of Missouri, Inc. filed an application for an investigation into the wire centers that AT&T Missouri asserts are non-impaired under the Federal Communications Commission's Triennial Review Remand Order.¹

Because AT&T is a necessary party to this matter, the Commission will join AT&T and require that AT&T respond to NuVox Communications' application.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. AT&T Missouri shall file a response to NuVox Communications of Missouri, Inc.'s application no later than April 20, 2006.
