**SECOND MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and for its motion states:

1. On November 20, 2008, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company d/b/a AT&T Missouri filed an Application and Motion for Expedited Treatment under 47 C.F.R. 52.15(g)(3)(iv) requesting that the Missouri Public Service Commission review and reverse a decision of the North American Numbering Plan Administrator (NANPA), NeuStar, Inc., to withhold certain numbering resources from AT&T Missouri.

2. On November 21, 2008, the Commission granted AT&T Missouri's Motion for Expedited Treatment and directed the Staff to file a recommendation no later than December 5, 2008, or as soon as possible thereafter.

3. On December 5, 2008, the Staff filed its first motion for an extension of time. The Staff explained that it had requested additional information from AT&T Missouri and would need time after the information is received to prepare a recommendation.

4. AT&T Missouri has requested and is waiting for information from a third party. The Staff will use the information to analyze the Application and to prepare its recommendation.

WHEREFORE, the Staff requests an extension to December 24, 2008 to file its recommendation.
