ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE

On December 5, 2008, Phone1, Inc. filed a notice of surrender of its certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services.

In Case Number TA-2005-0098, the Commission granted Phone1, Inc. a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in the state of Missouri.

On December 29, 2008 the Staff of the Commission filed its Staff Recommendation and stated the company owes no past assessments to the Commission, is not delinquent filing annual reports, and is not providing any regulated intrastate services to customers in Missouri. Staff recommended the Commission cancel Phone1's certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff.

The Commission has the authority to cancel a certificate and tariff pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo, which states, in part, "[a]ny certificate or service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected."

Based on Phone1's request and Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds that the certificate of service authority and tariff granted to Phone1, Inc. shall be canceled.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The certificate of authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services granted to Phone1, Inc., in Case Number TA-2005-0098, is canceled.
2. Phone1, Inc.'s tariff, PSC Mo. No. 1, is canceled.
3. This order shall become effective on January 12, 2009.
4. This case may be closed on January 13, 2009.
