## ORDER CANCELING ETC DESIGNATION

Issue Date: December 9, 2014

Effective Date: December 19, 2014

On November 25, 2014, the Commission's Staff filed a motion asking the Commission to cancel the Eligible Telecommunications Carrier (ETC) status of ExOp of Missouri, Inc., d/b/a FairPoint Communications. Staff's motion explains that ExOp has contacted Staff and asked to relinquish its ETC status in its Kearney and Platte City, Missouri exchanges.<sup>1</sup> The Commission ordered that anyone wishing to respond to Staff's motion do so no later than December 5. No one has responded.

The Commission will grant Staff's unopposed motion.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. ExOp of Missouri, Inc., d/b/a FairPoint Communications' designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier for the receipt of low-income support from the federal Universal Service Fund in its Kearney and Platte City, Missouri exchanges is cancelled.
