## ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

On June 19<sup>1</sup>, Seges Partners Mobile Home Park, L.L.C. ("Seges"), filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission. The Commission ordered its Staff (hereafter "Staff") to file a recommendation or status report no later than August 20.

On August 13, Staff filed Staff's Request for Correction of Seges Deficient Application and New Date for Staff Recommendation or Status Filing. Staff stated that an applicant for a certificate of convenience and necessity to operate a water system is required to file a plat map showing the area to be served, and a feasibility study regarding how the service is proposed to be offered.<sup>2</sup>

Staff averred that Seges has failed to submit that information; therefore, Staff stated that it is unable to provide a full and fair recommendation by August 20. Staff asked the Commission to order Seges to correct the deficiencies in its application by a date certain, and to extend Staff's deadline to file a Recommendation or Status Report.

The Commission granted Staff's request, and ordered Seges to supplement its application no later than September 15. Seges has failed to respond to the Commission's

order. The Commission will order Seges to show cause why its application should not be dismissed.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Seges Partners Mobile Home Park, L.L.C. shall show cause no later than

January 13, 2009, why its application should not be dismissed.

2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
