ORDER SCHEDULING INITIAL ARBITRATION MEETING

On October 4, 2005, a number of small rural carriers¹ filed a petition for arbitration with the Missouri Public Service Commission pursuant to the Telecommunications Act of 1996, requesting that the Commission arbitrate unresolved issues with U.S. Cellular. U.S. Cellular's response is due October 31, 2005. The federal Telecommunications Act requires that this arbitration be completed by January 24, 2005.

Due to the short amount of time available for this arbitration, the arbitrator will immediately schedule an initial arbitration meeting. At this initial meeting, the parties will be expected to consider and propose a procedural schedule that will allow this arbitration to proceed in the time allowed by statute.
