On August 10, 2007, Darrell Townsley filed a motion asking leave to appear on behalf of MCImetro Access Transmission Services L.L.C., d/b/a Verizon Access Transmission Services ("Verizon Access"). Mr. Townsley is a member in good standing of the bar in Illinois. He is not admitted to practice in Missouri. The motion, and his separately filed entry of appearance, designates Carl J. Lumley, a member of the Missouri bar, to serve as his associate counsel.¹ In a separate pleading (the Petition for Arbitration filed on August 8, 2007 as captioned above) Carl J. Lumley entered his appearance as associate counsel. A receipt indicating payment of the fees required by Missouri Supreme Court Rule 6.01(m) is attached to the motion.

The request for leave to appear complies with the requirements of 4 CSR 240-2.040(3)(C), and Missouri Supreme Court Rules 6.01(m) and 9.03. Mr. Townsley will be allowed to appear on behalf of Verizon Access.
