**ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE
AND NECESSITY AND CANCELING ASSOCIATED TARIFF**

On November 4, 2014, Kimberling City Water Company ("KCWC") filed an application. That application requested, among other things, authority from the Commission for KCWC to transfer its water system to Upper White River Basin Foundation, Inc. ("UWRB"). The Commission granted the application on January 21, 2015.

As required in the Commission's order granting the application, on February 22, 2015, KCWC notified the Commission that the transfer was complete. Accordingly, KCWC filed a motion in which it asked the Commission to cancel its certificate of convenience and necessity and corresponding tariff. Staff responded on March 6, 2015, recommending that the Commission grant KCWC's motion.

The Commission will grant KCWC's motion.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Motion to Cancel Certificate and Tariff filed by Kimberling City Water Company is granted.

2. The certificate of convenience and necessity to provide water service granted to Kimberling City Water Company in Case No. WA-82-4 is canceled.
3. The tariff allowing Kimberling City Water Company to provide water service is canceled.
4. This order shall be effective when issued.
5. This case shall be closed on March 18, 2015.
