- JUDGE PRIDGIN: Good morning, we're on
- 3 the record. This is the pre-hearing conference in
- 4 Case No. WO-2007-0344, in the matter of the request of
- 5 the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission
- 6 for an order directing the General Counsel to petition
- 7 the Circuit Court of Cole County for the appointment
- 8 of a receiver for Roque Creek Utilities, Inc. and for
- 9 the appointment of an interim receiver.
- 10 I am Ron Pridgin, I'm the Regulatory Law Judge
- 11 assigned to preside over this pre-hearing conference
- 12 being held on May 21, 2007. We are in the Governor's
- 13 Office Building in Jefferson City, Missouri. The time
- 14 is about five after ten in the morning.
- 15 I would like to get entries of appearance from
- 16 counsel, beginning with the General Counsel's Office,
- 17 please.
- 18 MR. KRUEGER: Keith R. Krueger for the
- 19 Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission. My
- 20 address is P.O. Box 360, Jefferson City, Missouri
- 21 65102.
- JUDGE PRIDGIN: Mr. Krueger, thank you. On
- 23 behalf of the Office of the Public Counsel, please.
- MS. BAKER: Christina Baker, P.O. Box 2230,
- 25 Jefferson City, Missouri 65102, appearing for the

- 1 Office of Public Counsel and the rate payers.
- JUDGE PRIDGIN: Ms. Baker, thank you. On
- 3 behalf of Rogue Creek Utilities, Inc., please.
- 4 MR. KARRAKER: I'm not really sure that I'm
- 5 representing the corporation. I kind of don't think I
- 6 am.
- JUDGE PRIDGIN: Very good. Mr. Karraker,
- 8 if you could just give your appearance and your
- 9 client, please?
- 10 MR. KARRAKER: My name is Kevan Karraker,
- 11 Missouri Bar No. 31279. My mailing address is P.O.
- 12 Box 454, Farmington, Missouri, and I am entering
- 13 for -- have entered for William Rummel, who was the
- 14 sole shareholder of Rogue Creek Utilities, Inc.
- 15 JUDGE PRIDGIN: Thank you, Mr. Karraker.
- 16 Is there any separate counsel entering an appearance
- 17 for Rogue Creek Utilities? Hearing none.
- 18 I understand that, I believe it's Joe and Rita
- 19 Coleman -- if I have their names correct -- perhaps
- 20 planned to participate in this pre-hearing conference.
- 21 Are either Mr. or Mrs. Coleman present on the line?
- 22 Hearing nothing from them.
- 23 What I would like to do is see if there's anything
- 24 that counsel needs from me. Are there any pending
- 25 motions or anything that you feel like you need to

- 1 draw to my attention?
- 2 MR. KRUEGER: Not from Staff.
- 3 MS. BAKER: Not from Public Counsel.
- 4 MR. KARRAKER: None from Mr. Rummel.
- 5 JUDGE PRIDGIN: All right. It looks like,
- 6 from the pleadings, that the parties have minimal
- 7 dispute, if any, and I believe that the General
- 8 Counsel's Office pointed out the possibility of a
- 9 stipulation, and obviously, that would be the
- 10 preferable manner in disposing of this.
- 11 I'll alert the parties, and Mr. Karraker in
- 12 particular, that even if you do reach a stipulation,
- 13 there's a chance that the Commission would want to
- 14 hold some sort of hearing anyway, and that would be
- 15 more to question counsel than to try and get facts.
- 16 That is to make sure they are comfortable with the
- 17 party's agreement.
- MR. KARRAKER: That's fine.
- 19 JUDGE PRIDGIN: That's just something to
- 20 keep in mind, as you discuss, that you might want to
- 21 try to set aside a day or part of a day for a hearing,
- 22 even if you do reach a stipulation.
- I will leave the room and go off the record
- 24 shortly, and I will let you continue the call, and I
- 25 hope that you'll keep an ear out, if you will, for the

- 1 Colemans in case they join here briefly. And even if
- 2 not, if someone could take the trouble to contact them
- 3 to let them know what you've discussed in the
- 4 pre-hearing conference.
- 5 I'll move the telephone over to the counsel table
- 6 so you can hear Mr. Karraker better and ask that you
- 7 disconnect the call when you're finished.
- 8 Is there anything else from counsel before I go
- 9 off the record?
- 10 MR. KRUEGER: No, Your Honor.
- MS. BAKER: No, Your Honor.
- MR. KARRAKER: No, Your Honor.
- JUDGE PRIDGIN: Very good. That will
- 14 conclude the on-the-record portion of the pre-hearing
- 15 conference in Case No. WO-2007-0344. Thank you very
- 16 much, we are off the record.
