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JOINT APPLICATION

WorldxChange Corp. ("WXC"), and Local Telcom Holdings, LLC d/b/a Transpoint Communications ("Transpoint") (together, "Applicants"), through their undersigned counsel and pursuant to Mo. Rev. Stat. §392.300 hereby request that the Commission grant authority to permit Applicants to consummate a series of transactions through which WXC will acquire indirect ownership of Transpoint and subsequently, transfer direct ownership of the regulated assets of Transpoint including Transpoint's Missouri customer base to WXC. As described in greater detail below, Applicants also respectfully request approval to abandon Transpoint's Missouri authorization contingent upon consummation of the transactions proposed herein ("Transactions").

In connection with the Transactions, Applicants seek a waiver of 4 CSR 240-33.150, the Commission's rule on presubscribed carrier changes, to enable Applicants to migrate Transpoint's customers from Transpoint to WXC without having to obtain a written authorization from each of

Transpoint's presubscribed customers.¹ Immediately following the proposed Transactions, Transpoint's customers will continue to receive services from WXC under the same rates, terms and conditions of service as the services currently provided by Transpoint. As a result, the Transactions, other than changing the name of the providing carrier, will be virtually transparent to all of Transpoint's customers in terms of the services they receive.

Applicants respectfully request that the Commission approve this Application as expeditiously as possible in order to allow Applicants to consummate the proposed Transactions as soon as possible.

In support of this Application, Applicants state as follows:

I. <u>Description of Applicants</u>

A. WorldxChange Corp.

- 1. WXC is a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Delaware with principal offices located at 9775 Business Park Avenue, San Diego, California 92131. WXC is a wholly owned indirect subsidiary of I-Link Incorporated. I-Link Incorporated is a publicly traded Florida corporation which is indirectly majority owned and controlled by Counsel Corp. ("Counsel"). Counsel is a publicly traded Canadian corporation that specializes in investments, including investments in communications companies.
- 2. In Missouri, WXC is authorized to provide interexchange service pursuant to certification granted by the Commission in Case No. TA-2000-847, issued on June 23, 2000. WXC

has been duly authorized by the Secretary of the State of Missouri to transact business as a foreign entity. A copy of WXCs Certificate of Good Standing from the Missouri Secretary of State is attached hereto *Exhibit A*. Further information concerning WXC's legal, technical, managerial and financial qualifications to provide service was submitted with its application for certification with the Commission and is, therefore, a matter of public record. WXC respectfully requests that the Commission take official notice of that information and incorporate it herein by reference.

B. Local Telcom Holdings, LLC d/b/a Transpoint Communications ("Transpoint")

3. Transpoint is a Delaware limited liability company with principal offices located at 28118 Agoura Road, Suite 201, Agoura Hills, California 91302. In Missouri, Transpoint provides intrastate toll service by virtue of certification granted by the Commission in Case No. TA-2001-659, issued on June 28, 2001. Transpoint has been duly authorized by the Secretary of the State of Missouri to transact business as a foreign entity and has duly registered its fictitious name. A copy of Transpoint's Certificate of Good Standing and a copy of its fictitious name registration from the Missouri Secretary of State are attached collectively hereto as *Exhibit B*. Transpoint's current Missouri operations consist of the provision of resold interexchange services to residential and commercial customers. Further information concerning Transpoint was submitted with its application for certification, is a matter of public record and is incorporated herein by reference.

III. Description of the Transactions

5. WXC and Transpoint plan to consummate a series of Transactions whereby WXC will acquire the Missouri assets and customer base of Transpoint and Transpoint will subsequently cease to operate. In particular, the Transactions currently contemplated by Applicants include:

Step 1: A newly formed, wholly owned holding company subsidiary of WXC, Transpoint Holdings Corporation ("THC"), will acquire all of the stock of Transpoint. As a result, Transpoint will become a wholly-owned subsidiary of WXC through THC.

- Step 2: Following the indirect acquisition of Transpoint by WXC, all of Transpoint's customers and other operating assets will be assigned on an intra-corporate family basis from Transpoint to WXC. Once the customer assignment is complete, WXC will assume the service obligations to current Transpoint customers.
- Step 3: After all of Transpoint's customers and assets have been transferred to WXC, Transpoint will relinquish its authority and will cease to operate in Missouri.
- 6. In order to complete the proposed series of Transactions, Applicants have entered into several agreements, including a Purchase Agreement, as amended (through which the change in ownership of Transpoint described in Step 1 above will be completed) and an Asset Purchase Agreement, as amended (which relates to the assignment of customers and assets described in Step 2 above).² A chart illustrating the proposed Transactions is provided in Exhibit C.
- 7. The assets to be acquired by WXC include, among other things, all of the regulated operations of Transpoint in Missouri, including Transpoint's existing customer base. Because WXC is already authorized to provide the services Transpoint provides in Missouri, WXC is not seeking authority to acquire Transpoint's operating authority in Missouri.
- 8. Instead, because WXC proposes to acquire Transpoint's entire customer base and Applicants expect to wind-down Transpoint following the consummation of the Transactions, Applicants respectfully request that through this proceeding the Commission grant any authority necessary to permit Transpoint to discontinue service upon consummation of the Transactions and

permit Transpoint to relinquish its Missouri certification. In order to permit Applicants sufficient time to close the Transactions after approval, however, Applicants respectfully request that the Commission condition such revocation on the consummation of the proposed Transactions and not on Commission approval. Following consummation, Applicants will file post-consummation notice with the Commission.

- 9. The proposed Transactions will not directly affect the rates, terms and conditions under which Transpoint customers receive service. WXC and Transpoint have agreed to work together to ensure that Transpoint's customers are transferred seamlessly between Applicants and that no interruptions in service will occur. As mentioned at the beginning of this application, in connection with transfer of Transpoint's customers from Transpoint to WXC, Applicants seek a waiver, to the extent necessary, of the 4 CSR 240-33.150 to enable Applicants to migrate Transpoint's presubscribed customers from Transpoint to WXC.³ To the extent necessary, WXC will also adopt Transpoint's tariffs or make other appropriate filings to ensure the seamless transition of Transpoint's customers to WXC. As a result, the Transactions will be (other than the change in the name of their service provider) virtually transparent to Transpoint's customers in terms of the services they receive.
- 10. Neither of the Applicants has pending or final judgments or decisions against it or its affiliates from any state or federal agency or court that involve customer services or rates. No annual

Applicants seek a waiver of the requirements of 4 CSR 240-33.150 since the transfer of customers in this matter will be in the context of a transfer of assets subject to the supervision and approval of the Commission, and in that manner the goals and purposes of the slamming rule are being upheld. Insisting on adherence to the slamming rule in this case would be confusing to the customers, and therefore be offensive to the public interest. In conformance with conformance with FCC and state law, Applicants have provided pre-consummation notice to Transpoint's customers using the format provided in Exhibit D.

report or assessment fees are overdue to the Commission from the Applicants. No impact is anticipated on the tax revenues of any political subdivision in which the Applicants are located.

IV. Public Interest Considerations

- 11. Applicants respectfully submit that the proposed Transactions serve the public interest. In particular, Applicants submit that (1) the Transactions will increase competition in the Missouri telecommunications market by reinforcing the status of WorldxChange as a viable competitor, and (2) the Transactions will minimize the disruption of service and be virtually transparent to Transpoint's customers.
- 12. The proposed Transactions are expected to facilitate competition in Missouri by improving the operational position of WXC. The proposed Transactions will permit WXC and Transpoint to combine their complimentary management skills and assets, thereby enhancing WXC's operational flexibility and financial viability. At the same time, the expansion of WXC's customer base which will occur as a result of the transfer of Transpoint's customers to WXC will improve WXC's position in the Missouri telecommunications market and permit WXC to compete more effectively against larger carriers in Missouri.
- The proposed Transactions will also ensure that customers of Transpoint continue to receive high quality communications services. As noted above, the Transactions will not affect the rates, terms and conditions of the services that current Transpoint customers receive. In addition, WXC and Transpoint have agreed to work closely together to prevent transaction related service interruptions. As a result, the proposed Transactions will be virtually transparent to customers with respect to the services they receive.

V. Conclusion

For the reasons stated above, Applicants respectfully submit that the public interest, convenience, and necessity would be furthered by a grant of this Application. Accordingly, Applicants respectfully request expedited treatment to permit Applicants to consummate the Transactions described herein as soon as possible.





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

Post-Transaction


