

Since that time, AWI has not participated in any high-cost USF support programs while the company prepares to seek application for high-cost Connect America Fund territories to serve. Because of the recency of being granted ETC status, AWI has not developed or specifically tailored a line extension policy for requests when an applicant for high-cost services requests service to a previously un-served area.
