Page 4 1 (The following proceedings began at 6:08 p.m.:) 2 JUDGE KEELING: Let's go on the record. First 3 I would like to ask everyone to mute themselves unless they're speaking. That will cut down on the noise level 4 5 and prevent the audio feedback. And if you don't have a 6 mute button or perhaps can't find it, I believe that the 7 *6 button will also mute and unmute your phone. Today is August 11, 2022. The Missouri Public 8 9 Service Commission has set this time for a local public 10 hearing in a case File No. WR-2022-0345, which is 11 captioned as In the Matter of Argyle Estates Water Supply's Request for a Water Rate Increase. 12 The Commission has scheduled this local public 13 hearing to give members of the public a chance to 14 15 comment about Argyle Estates application. The Missouri Public Service Commission regulates the rates charged by 16 17 public utility companies in Missouri to ensure that those rates are just and reasonable. The Commission 18 also regulates the guality of service and safety of the 19 20 operations of public utilities. 21 The Commission is made up of five 2.2 Commissioners. The Commissioners are appointed by the 23 Governor to fixed terms and confirmed by the Senate. The Commissioners employ a staff of engineers, 24 25 accountants, attorneys, financial analysts, and other

Page 5 specialists in the field of utility regulation. 1 2 My name is Ross Keeling. I'm a Regulatory Law Judge for the Commission and I'll be presiding over this 3 4 hearing. With me today are Commissioner Coleman, and 5 are there any other Commissioners that have come in after that? Just Commissioner Coleman. 6 7 This is an official hearing of the Missouri Public Service Commission, and the statements and 8 9 testimony of witnesses will be recorded by a court 10 reporter. They must be given under oath. 11 All of the Commissioners will have the 12 opportunity to read the witnesses' remarks, and additionally I'll brief the Commissioners on what was 13 said here tonight. And the Commissioners value your 14 15 comments and input. 16 Commissioners, would you -- Commissioner 17 Coleman, would you like to make any opening remarks? 18 COMMISSIONER COLEMAN: Can you hear me? 19 JUDGE KEELING: I can hear you, Commissioner. 20 COMMISSIONER COLEMAN: Great. It's sometimes 21 hard to unmute. Only that we appreciate those who are 2.2 there tonight to provide us with information regarding 23 Thank you for your time and attention to this this. 24 Thank you, Judge. matter. 25 JUDGE KEELING: Thank you, Commissioner.
