1	JUDGE STEARLEY: All right. It's
2	Monday, January 3, 2011 [sic]. We set this time
3	for a procedural conference in the matter
4	captioned Rita Hill versus Missouri-American
5	Water Company, File No. WC-2011-0111. My name's
6	Harold Stearley. I'm the presiding officer over
7	this matter.
8	The court reporter this afternoon is
9	Nancy Silva, and I'll begin by taking entries of
10	appearance beginning with Staff of the Missouri
11	Public Service Commission.
12	MR. THOMPSON: This is Kevin Thompson
13	representing Staff of the Commission, P.O. Box
14	360, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102.
15	JUDGE STEARLEY: Thank you very much,
16	Mr. Thompson.
17	MR. JONES: This is Ken Jones for
18	Missouri-American Water Company, 727 Craig Road,
19	St. Louis, Missouri 63141.
20	JUDGE STEARLEY: Thank you,
21	Mr. Jones.
22	And Ms. Hill, would you please enter
23	your appearance for us.
24	MS. HILL: My name's Rita Hill, and
25	my address is P.O. Box 38331, St. Louis,

1	Missouri 63138.
2	JUDGE STEARLEY: Thank you, Ms. Hill.
3	And we'll let the record reflect there's
4	no one present for the Office of the Public Counsel.
5	As I understand this case, the status
6	right now, we've had a billing dispute, and the last
7	I saw, Missouri-American had offered to waive a
8	tariff fee and it issued a corrected bill. Is that
9	correct, Mr. Jones?
10	MR. JONES: Well, I'm not I'm not
11	positive, Judge, that the corrected bill has been
12	issued yet or whether we were waiting for the for
13	this procedural conference to be completed but, yeah,
14	we stated we would waive the \$25 fee plus the \$61 fee
15	as Staff had suggested.
16	JUDGE STEARLEY: Okay. And if you waived
17	both of those fees, the 25 and the 61, what would the
18	corrected bill be?
19	MR. JONES: It would be somewhere in the
20	area of \$41.59.
21	JUDGE STEARLEY: All right. I believe
22	that's what Staff has as well.
23	I'm sorry. Did I interrupt someone
24	there?
25	MS. HILL: I'm sorry, your Honor. I guess

I received the notice on the Staff for their recommendation and I received a letter from MA -- from the water company about the 25, and I'm okay with \$41. That -- that will be reasonable for me, so if it would speed it up, I'm good with that, if you can order that.

JUDGE STEARLEY: All right. Well, it

JUDGE STEARLEY: All right. Well, it sounds as though Missouri-American has settlement offer on the table, that you're willing to accept, Ms. Hill.

MS. HILL: Yes, sir.

need to do is I will need to have the parties finalize that and have one of you file a notice in the case that you're willing to voluntarily dismiss the case, that the matter's been settled. And Staff and Mr. Jones could explain the technical details of that. They could even draft up that notice and --

MR. THOMPSON: Why don't we do it like this, Ms. Hill: When you receive the corrected bill for that amount, give us a call and we will go ahead, with your permission, and file a document with the Commission.

MS. HILL: That sounds great. Do you know when I'll get a bill, because the only thing I got

1	was a notice that it was sent to a collection agency,
2	and I didn't want that because I wanted to try to
3	speak with the
4	MR. THOMPSON: Right. Shouldn't
5	shouldn't be going to any collection agency.
6	Mr. Jones, when will she get her bill?
7	Do you know?
8	MR. JONES: You know, if I get they
9	could probably do the adjustment tomorrow and get it
10	in the mail, but let me confirm that it should be
11	within the next two or three days.
12	JUDGE STEARLEY: And Mr. Jones, can you be
13	sure that does not go to a collection agency?
14	MR. JONES: Yes.
15	MS. HILL: Okay, 'cause I have a notice
16	here from a collection agency, from Pan Credit.
17	MR. JONES: What was the date of that
18	notice?
19	MS. HILL: December 6, 2010.
20	MR. JONES: Yeah, that was that was
21	several weeks ago, and I don't think it has been I
22	think it's been put abeyance since then.
23	JUDGE STEARLEY: If you could, please
24	follow up on that, Mr. Jones, and make sure there's
25	nothing outstanding with the credit agency that might

1	affect Ms. Hill's credit.
2	MR. JONES: Surely, your Honor.
3	JUDGE STEARLEY: All right. Very well.
4	Well, it doesn't sound like there's a great deal more
5	I need to discuss with you-all. We are kind of
6	double-teaming with the parties on the phone here.
7	I'm going to leave it to you-all. If you need to get
8	together by phone, follow up on this and file some
9	type of notice in the case, say
10	MR. THOMPSON: Just repeating what's
11	happened today?
12	JUDGE STEARLEY: Yeah. Yeah. Why don't
13	you do that.
14	MR. THOMPSON: We'll do it.
15	JUDGE STEARLEY: We'll just kind of go
16	from there.
17	MR. THOMPSON: Yes, sir.
18	MR. JONES: And I will contact
19	Mr. Thompson tomorrow and let him know the results of
20	my discussions with billing just to let him know that
21	it's being processed tomorrow.
22	MR. THOMPSON: Wonderful.
23	JUDGE STEARLEY: Sounds very good. Is
24	there anything else we need to take up at this point?
25	MS. HILL: So I just wait on the bill and

1	just pay the \$41.
2	MR. THOMPSON: We would like to talk with
3	somebody, Mr. Jones, yourself, or somebody else from
4	the company about how it's interpreting and applying
5	the tariff having to do with temporary service.
6	MR. JONES: Sure. And we just filed today
7	our responses to Staff's data request.
8	MR. THOMPSON: Yeah.
9	MR. JONES: That might answer some of the
10	questions, but that was going to be a follow-up
11	question: With this specific case being resolved,
12	how does that affect the
13	JUDGE STEARLEY: Well, the Commission has
14	issued an order in this case authorizing Staff to
15	make its investigation, and as far as the
16	Commission's concerned, Staff has investigatory power
17	to go ahead and proceed if they've got some tariff
18	questions with you.
19	If Staff decides there's some issue that
20	would require Staff to file a separate complaint
21	MR. THOMPSON: At this time let me
22	hasten to say, Staff's not contemplating a complaint.
23	What we desire is just an informal discussion between
24	Mr. Merciel in our water and sewer department and
25	somebody from the company, his opposite member,

1	whoever that would be, so we can reach a meeting
2	of the minds with respect to interpreting and
3	applying the temporary service tariff.
4	MR. JONES: Sure, and the response to
5	the data request might might make some of
6	that clear.
7	MR. THOMPSON: I think we've gotten
8	that. We've reviewed it. It was helpful. Now
9	we've got to talk.
10	MR. JONES: Very good.
11	JUDGE STEARLEY: I believe that
12	discussion can occur outside the boundaries of
13	this particular case.
14	MR. THOMPSON: Absolutely, Judge.
15	JUDGE STEARLEY: Ms. Hill's got her
16	matter settled.
17	MR. THOMPSON: Very well.
18	JUDGE STEARLEY: All right. Well, I
19	thank you all for the meeting, and I thank the
20	other parties on the line, and I apologize for
21	the inconvenience we called interrupting this
22	afternoon.
23	MR. THOMPSON: Thank you, your Honor.
24	JUDGE STEARLEY: Thank you all very
25	much.
