ORDER CONSOLIDATING CASES AND GRANTING LEAVE TO AMEND PETITION

Issue Date: September 28, 2021 Effective Date: September 28, 2021 On September 3, 2021, Missouri-American Water Company (MAWC) filed its petition to establish water and sewer infrastructure rate adjustments (WSIRAs) under Sections 393.1500-1509, RSMo. MAWC also requested that the Commission approve its proposed customer notices and filed tariff sheets to implement the WISRAs. On September 9, 2021, the Commission suspended the tariff sheets until March 2, 2022, set deadlines from intervention requests, Staff's recommendation and objections to the application.

On September 8, 2021, MAWC filed a motion requesting the Commission consolidate the water case (File No. WO-2021-0428) and sewer case (File No. SO-2021-0429) into one matter. No responses to the motion were received. Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.110(3) permits the consolidation of pending actions that involve related questions of law or fact. Since the cases will involve common facts, parties, and issues, the Commission will grant the motion.

On September 17, 2021, MAWC filed a motion for leave to amend paragraph 10 of its petition to clarify MAWC's request regarding pending infrastructure system replacement surcharge investments. Commission Rule 20 CSR 240-2.080(18) provides

that a pleading may be amended at any time by leave of the Commission. No other party has filed a pleading in these cases and the amendment may aid in providing clarification for the other parties' review. Therefore, the Commission will grant leave to amend the petition.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. MAWC's motion to consolidate is granted. File Nos. WO-2021-0428 and SO-2021-0429 are hereby consolidated, with File No. WO-2021-0428 being the lead case.

- 2. MAWC's motion for leave to amend its petition is granted.
- 3. This order shall be effective when issued.
