SUPPLEMENTAL APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL OF INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT

COMES NOW Universal Telecom, Inc., ("UTI"), a Kentucky corporation authorized to do business in Missouri, by and through its undersigned counsel, and hereby applies for approval of its Interconnection Agreement with ALLTEL Communications Service Corporation ("ALLTEL").

In accordance with the Order Directing Filing, effective December 23, 2000, and 4 CSR 240-2.060(1)(G), UTI incorporates by reference herein the applicable information as set forth in 4 CSR-2.060(1)(B)-(F) submitted in previous UTI applications in Case Nos. TO-2001-188 (Sprint); TO-2001-84 (Spectra Communications Group); TO-2001-75 (TDS Telecommunications); TA-2000-598 (UTI's Application for authority to provide basis local exchange services); and TO-2000-526 (GTE Midwest Inc.). The information contained in the previously filed applications and requested in the Order Directing Filing remains current and correct.

Effective October 21, 2000, UTI was granted a certificate to provide basic local and interexchange telecommunications services in Case No. TA-2000-598. The grant of UTI's Certificate is conditional until such time as the Public Service Commission approves its tariff, which was issued October 6, 2000. In accordance with the Commission's regulations, an original and eight (8) copies of the Interconnection Agreement have previously been submitted to the Commission.

In accordance with 4 CSR 240-2.060(1)(K), UTI has no pending action or final unsatisfied judgments or decisions against it from any state or federal agency or court which involve customer

service or rates within three (3) years of the date of this Application. Further, in accordance with 4 CSR 240-2.060(L), no annual reports or assessment fees on behalf of UTI are overdue at this time.

In accordance with 4 CSR 240-2.060(1)(M), a letter from an authorized representative of UTI authorizing the undersigned attorney to subscribe and verify the contents of the Application will be filed separately pursuant to 4 CSR 240.060(2). The letter will be filed prior to the granting of the authority sought.

WHEREFORE, UTI respectfully requests that the Missouri Public Service Commission approve its Interconnection Agreement with ALLTEL Communication Service Corporation as herein requested.
