MOTION FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT

COMES NOW Missouri-American Water Company ("MAWC"), and for its Motion for Expedited Treatment pursuant to Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.080(14), respectfully states as follows to the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission"):

- 1. MAWC filed its WSIRA petition on September 3, 2021. By an Order Approving Water and Sewer Infrastructure Rate Adjustments ("Order") issued January 12, 2022, the Commission approved annual WSIRA surcharge revenues \$16,135,000 for St. Louis County water, \$2,659,795 for All Other water, \$42,491 for Arnold sewer, and \$165,495 for All Other sewer for a total of \$19,002,781, authorized MAWC to file tariff sheets to recover WSIRA revenues and rates as set out in the exemplar tariff sheets attached to its December 13, 2021 response as Appendix A Revised and Appendix B Revised, and directed MAWC to file tariff sheets to eliminate any existing ISRS prior to WSIRA becoming effective.
- 2. The revised WSIRA tariff sheets, Tracking Nos. YW-2022-0204 and YS-2022-0205, are attached hereto. Although the tariffs bear an effective date 30 days after issuance, MAWC requests that the tariffs be allowed to take effect for service rendered on and after February 1, 2022, or as soon thereafter as is reasonable.
- 3. Pursuant to Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.080(14), MAWC submits that the tariff sheets are being filed in compliance with the Commission's *Order*; and, the tariff

sheet would implement rates in accordance with Sections 393.1000-1006, RSMo. in regard to plant that has been placed into service between January 1, 2021 and October 31, 2021, and which is currently used and useful and providing service to customers. Therefore, a grant of this Motion would provide rate recognition of this plant at a rate recognized by statute and is in the public interest. MAWC further states that this Motion is being filed as quickly as possible after the Commission issued its Order.

WHEREFORE, MAWC respectfully requests an order of the Commission granting this motion and allowing the revised WSIRA tariff sheets, Tracking Nos. YW-2022-0204 and YS-2022-0205 to take effect for service rendered on and after February 1, 2022, or as soon thereafter as is reasonable. MAWC requests such additional relief as is necessary or appropriate under the circumstances.
