ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION

On December 15, 2006, Missouri-American Water Company submitted to the Commission proposed tariff sheets intended to implement a general rate increase for water and sewer service. The Commission issued an Order and Notice on January 3, 2007, in which it gave interested parties until January 16, 2007 to request intervention.

On February 8, 2007, the City of Parkville, Missouri filed an Application to Intervene. The City of Parkville stated that it was aware of the January 16 deadline; however, the Applicant's Mayor determined the Board of Aldermen needed to approve the filing of the intervention. That approval took place on February 6, 2007. The City of Parkville, through its Attorney, entered an appearance at the February 7 early prehearing conference before the Commission. No party objected.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075 governs intervention before the Commission. That rule states that the Commission may allow a party to intervene if the proposed intervenor has an interest that is different from that of the general public and which may be adversely affected by a final order arising from the case, or granting the proposed intervention would serve the public interest. The Commission finds that the proposed

intervenor has an interest that is different from that of the general public and that may be adversely affected by a final order arising from the case, and that granting the proposed intervention would serve the public interest. Therefore, the Commission will grant the City of Parkville's application to intervene.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application to intervene filed by the City of Parkville, is granted.
2. This order shall become effective on February 13, 2007.
