ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTIONS

ISSUE DATE: January 26, 2007

EFFECTIVE DATE: January 26, 2007

On December 15, 2006, Missouri-American Water Company requested that the Commission approve its water and sewer tariffs that would implement general rate increases. The Commission issued an order suspending the tariff sheets and directing notice on January 3, 2007. In that order, the Commission directed that interested parties should file their applications to intervene on or before January 16, 2007.

On January 16, 2007, The Boeing Company, DaimlerChrysler, GKN, Hussmann Refrigeration, Monsanto Company and Pfizer, collectively referred to as the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers, the City of St. Joseph, Missouri, the Metropolitan St. Louis Sewer District, and the City of Jefferson City, Missouri filed separate applications to intervene. No objections to the interventions were received.

The Commission finds that the requests for intervention are in compliance with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075. The Commission further finds that the intervenors have an interest in this proceeding that is different from that of the general public. The

Commission shall grant the requests to intervene. The intervenors are directed to comply with the procedural orders of this case.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers' Application to Intervene is granted.
2. The City of St. Joseph, Missouri's Application to Intervene is granted.
3. The Metropolitan St. Louis Sewer District's Application to Intervene is granted.
4. The City of Jefferson City, Missouri's Application to Intervene is granted.
5. The Data Center shall add the above-named companies as parties to this case.
6. The intervenors shall comply with the procedural orders of this case.
7. This order will become effective on January 26, 2007.
