ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO SUPPLEMENT REBUTTAL TESTIMONY

On September 30, 2008, the City of Riverside and the Missouri Gaming Company filed rebuttal testimony of Donald E. Johnstone. On October 2, the City and MGC filed a motion to supplement the testimony with the affidavit of Mr. Johnstone.

Commission rule 4 CSR 240-130(8) allows a party to supplement prefiled testimony by order of the judge or the Commission. Because the supplement to the testimony is ministerial rather than substantive, the judge will immediately grant the motion. However, if for any reason a party to this matter would oppose the motion, this order will bear a 10-day effective date to allow time for any objections.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The motion to supplement the testimony of Donald E. Johnstone filed by the City of Riverside and the Missouri Gaming Company is granted.

2. This order shall become effective on October 12, 2008.
