ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO STAY COMPLAINT

On November 19, 2013, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a complaint with the Missouri Public Service Commission against the above-referenced Respondent. Respondent did not file an answer to Staff’s complaint. On February 6, 2014, Staff filed its *Motion to Stay Complaint*, stating that the parties are engaged in settlement discussions. Staff reports that Respondents submitted payments for fiscal years 2013 and 2014 Commission assessments. Staff also indicates that the Office of Public Counsel does not object to the motion. Respondent did not file a response to Staff’s motion.¹

The Commission will grant Staff’s motion and stay the pending complaint action.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission will stay all action on the complaint until April 11, 2014.
