## <u>SECOND CUSTOMER NOTICE</u>

## April 6, 2015

## Dear Customer:

On October 27, 2014, Seges Partners Mobile Home Park, LLC (Company) submitted a request for an increase in its annual sewer operating revenues to the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission), under the provisions of the Commission's small utility rate case procedure. By its request, the Company was seeking changes to its customer rates intended to generate an increase in its annual sewer operating revenues of \$3,834. As the original rate case notification letter in October 2014 stated, the increase is to cover increased costs due to annual rate increases by the City of Holt's Summit for both the base charge and usage rate. This is per Section 115.060 subsection 1. of the Holt's Summit, Missouri city code that was approved on December 9, 2013 laying out a rate schedule for sewer charges through the year 2018 with increases going into effect on April 1<sup>st</sup> of each year. Please keep in mind Seges did not pass along the increase that went into effect on April 1, 2014 to our residents.

As a result of the Company's request, the Staff of the Public Service Commission (Commission Staff) conducted an independent audit of the Company's books and records, and an investigation of the Company's business and system operations. Based upon the results of its audit and investigation, the Commission Staff has concluded that an increase of \$2,178 in the Company's annual sewer operating revenues is warranted, that changes to and the addition of certain service charges are warranted. The Company has agreed with the Commission Staff's audit findings and conclusions, and has entered into an agreement with the Commission Staff to implement those findings and conclusions. Set out at the end of this notice is a table that summarizes the proposed revisions to the Company's rates, and that includes a monthly bill comparison for a residential customer using 6,000 gallons of water.

The Office of the Public Counsel (Public Counsel), a state agency responsible for representing the interests of utility consumers before the Commission, has reviewed the results of the Commission Staff's investigation and the related Company/Staff agreement. However, the Public Counsel has not yet taken a final position regarding those results or the provisions of the agreement.

Any customer that has comments about the proposed revisions to the Company's rates, or that has comments regarding service-related problems, should contact the Commission Staff and/or the Public Counsel *within 20 days of the date of this notice*.
