## ORDER DIRECTING PARTIES TO FILE PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

The Staff of the Commission filed a complaint against Ridge Creek Development, L.L.C. and Mike Stoner and Denise Stoner alleging that Respondents were operating a water system without a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity from the Commission. The Commission held a prehearing conference and the parties continued to discuss the matter.

Subsequently, Staff filed a motion requesting that the Commission direct the parties to file a procedural schedule. Staff informs the Commission that Ridge Creek Development, L.L.C. and Mike Stoner and Denise Stoner informed Staff of Respondents' intent to sell the company or to apply for a certificate. Neither has happened. Staff therefore wishes to proceed toward an evidentiary hearing. No party has responded to Staff's request. The Commission will therefore direct the parties to work together to file a proposed procedural schedule and to select a date for an evidentiary hearing. The Commission will adjust the schedule if necessary.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The parties shall work together to propose a procedural schedule.
- 2. Staff shall file the proposed procedural schedule, or a status report, no later than February 6, 2015.
  - 3. This order shall be effective when issued.
