## **REQUEST FOR EXTENSION**

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff"), by and through the undersigned counsel, and for its *Request For Extension* respectfully states:

- 1. On October 14, 2022, in the Commission's *Order Ending Suspension of the Procedural Schedule*, the Commission ordered Staff to file a recommendation no later than December 2, 2022.
- 2. Staff has issued additional Data Requests ("DRs") to both Missouri-American Water Company ("MAWC") and Ms. Nangle. Due to the pending impact of these responses, Staff is requesting a 60-day extension of time, which will grant the parties time to submit responses to the DRs and afford Staff the necessary time to perform its analysis of the facts in preparation of Staff's recommendation. Staff requests the Commission allow Staff to file its recommendation in this matter on or before January 31, 2023.

3. Staff notified Ms. Nangle and MAWC of its intent to request a 60-day extension to determine if either party objected. MAWC responded with its consent, but Staff has not heard back from Ms. Nangle as of the time of this filing.

WHEREFORE, Staff respectfully requests that the Commission issue an order granting Staff's request to file its recommendation on or before January 31, 2023, and grant such other and further relief as the Commission finds reasonable under the circumstances.
