# 7.0 SPECIAL ARRANGEMENTS

#### 7.1 Special Construction

### 7.1.1 Basis for Charges

Arrangements will be developed on a case-by-case basis in response to a bona fide request from a Customer or prospective Customer to develop a competitive bid for a special construction or Centrex-type service offered under this tariff. ICB rates will be offered to the Customer in writing and on a non-discriminatory basis. Rates for such services offered on an individual case basis will be structured to recover the Company's cost of providing the services. Terms of specific ICB contracts will be made available to the Commission upon request on a proprietary basis. Where the Company furnishes a facility or service for which a rate or charge is not specified in the Company's tariffs, charges will be based on the costs incurred by the Company and may include:

- A) non-recurring type charges;
- B) recurring type charges;
- C) termination liabilities; or
- D) combinations thereof.

#### 7.1.2 Termination Liability

To the extent that there is no other requirement for use by the Company, a termination liability may apply for facilities specially constructed at the request of the customer.
