Section 1. APPLICATION OF TARIFF

- 1.1.1 This tariff governs the services provided by Pac-West Telecomm, Inc. that originate and terminate within the State of Missouri. Specific services and rates are described elsewhere in this tariff. This tariff is applicable to the provision of services within the service areas and exchanges served by SBC, Sprint and CenturyTel.
- 1.1.2 The Company's installs operates, and maintains the communications services provided herein in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth under this tariff. It may act as the customer's agent for ordering access connection facilities provided by other carriers or entities when authorized by the customer, to allow connection of a customer's location to the Company's network.
