STATUS REPORT

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and for its Second Status Report states the following to the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission).

- 1. On November 28, 2006, Oakview Estates Water and Sewer Company, LLC (Company), filed applications with the Missouri Public Service Commission, pursuant to Section 393.170, RSMo 2000, requesting that the Commission grant it authority to provide water and sewer service to an unincorporated portion of Warren County, Missouri. The applications were assigned Case Nos. WA-2007-0201 and SA-2007-0200. The cases were consolidated by Commission Order on December 4, 2006, with Case No. WA-2007-0201 being designated the remaining lead case.
- 2. Also on December 4, 2006, the Commission issued its Order Directing Notice and Setting Date for Submission of Intervention Requests. The Order established December 21, 2006 as the deadline for the submission of intervention requests. There have been no requests for intervention.

- 3. On December 28, 2006, the Commission issued its Order Directing Filing, in which it directed the Staff to file its recommendation, or a status report indicating when it expects to file a recommendation, no later than January 29, 2007.
 - 4. Staff filed its Status Report on January 29, reporting as follows:
 - The Staff has reviewed the applications that are the subject of this consolidated case and found that they lack significant information that is required by 4 CSR 240-3.305(1)(A)5 and 4 CSR 240-3.600(1)(A)5, and which the Staff needs in order to make an appropriate and informed recommendation.
 - The Staff submitted Data Request No. 0001 to the Company's attorney in an attempt to obtain the information. The Company's response to this Data Request was due on February 13, 2007.
- 5. The Company has not responded to the data request. Staff filed a Motion for Waiver of 4 CSR 2-2.090(8)(B) and a Motion to Compel Response to Data Request on April 25, 2007. Staff requested the Commission to compel a response to the outstanding data request by May 8, 2007. There has been no ruling on these motions.
- 6. Since the filing of those motions, undersigned counsel has been in contact with the Company's attorney. No date for the submission of the information required of the data request has been set. Undersigned counsel is awaiting the receipt of information from the Company's attorney.
- 7. Staff anticipates this case will not be resolved within 90 days due the time Staff will require to issue its recommendation once the information required by the data request is furnished. Staff recommends that the Commission order the filing of a status report on the first

day of every other month. Staff recommends that its next three status reports be filed no later than July 2, September 3, and November 1, 2007.

WHEREFORE, Staff respectfully submits this Status Report for the Commission's information.
