COMPLAINT

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff), by and through counsel, and initiates this Complaint pursuant to Section 386.390 RSMo (2000)¹ and Rule 4 CSR 240-2.070, against NOW Intermedia, Inc. (NOW or the Company) for violation of Section 392.210.1 and Rule 4 CSR 240-3.540(1) relating to the filing of an annual report. In support of its Complaint, Staff respectfully states as follows:

- 1. NOW Intermedia, Inc. is a "telecommunications company" and "public utility" as defined in Section 386.020 and is subject to the jurisdiction of the Missouri Public Service Commission (the Commission) pursuant to Section 386.250.
- 2. In an Order² issued August 8, 2003, and effective August 15, 2003, the Commission granted NOW a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services and nonswitched local exchange telecommunications services in the State of Missouri.

- 3. Section 392.210.1 states that telecommunications companies must "file an annual report with the Commission at a time and covering the yearly period fixed by the commission."
- 4. The Company is incorporated under the laws of the State of Missouri and is listed as an "administratively dissolved" corporation by the Missouri Secretary of State.
- 5. As of the date of the filing of this Complaint, the Company's registered agent according to the Missouri Secretary of State is:

6. The Company has provided the following contact information to the Commission:

- 7. On January 15, 2008, the Executive Director of the Commission emailed to NOW a communication notifying the Company of the requirement to file an annual report covering the calendar year 2007. Attached to this email the Executive Director sent the appropriate form for the Company to complete and return to the Commission along with instructions on how the Company could complete its filing electronically. The email was sent to the address that was current in the Commission's Electronic Filing and Information System ("EFIS") but did not reach the contact person, so NOW was mailed a paper copy of the cover letter and form on January 23, 2008. *See* Exhibit A.
- 8. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.070(5)(E) requires "a statement as to whether the complainant has directly contacted the person, corporation or public utility about which complaint is being made." In addition to the correspondence sent by the Executive Director in January 2008, the Commission's General Counsel sent NOW follow up letters on May 27, 2008,

and October 14, 2008, notifying the Company that continued failure to submit an annual report may subject the Company to legal action to recover penalties as provided by state law. *See* Exhibit B.

- 9. On January 30, 2009, the Executive Director of the Commission emailed NOW notifying the Company of the requirement to file an annual report covering the calendar year 2008. *See* Exhibit C. The email was again returned and NOW was mailed a paper copy of the form and letter on March 5, 2009. *See* Exhibit C. A subsequent letter from the General Counsel's Office warning the company that they would be subject to penalties for failure to submit their annual report was sent on May 4, 2009. *See* Exhibit D.
- 10. Section 386.390.1 authorizes the Commission to entertain a complaint "setting forth any act or thing done or omitted to be done by any...public utility, in violation, or claimed to be in violation, of any provision of law, or of any rule, order or decision of the Commission."
- 11. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.070(1) provides that the Commission's Staff, through the General Counsel, may file a complaint.
- 12. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-3.540(1) requires all telecommunications companies to file their annual reports on or before April 15 of each year.
- 13. As of the date of the filing of this Complaint, the Company has not filed annual reports for the calendar years 2007 and 2008.
- 14. Section 392.210.1 provides that "[i]f any telecommunications company shall fail to make and file its annual report as and when required or within such extended time as the commission may allow. . . such company shall forfeit to the state the sum of one hundred dollars for each and every day it shall continue to be in default with respect to such report...."

15. If the Commission determines after a contested hearing that the Company failed, omitted, or neglected to file its annual report, the Commission may then authorize its General Counsel to bring a penalty action in the circuit court as provided for in Section 386.600.

16. The Missouri courts have imposed a duty upon the Public Service Commission to first determine matters within its jurisdiction before proceeding to those courts for statutory penalties. *See State v. Carroll*, 620 S.W.2d 22 (Mo. App. 1981); *see also State ex rel. Cirese v. Ridge*, 138 S.W.2d 1012 (Mo.banc 1940).

PRAYER FOR RELIEF

WHEREFORE, Staff now requests that the Commission open a complaint case pursuant to Section 386.390; and, after hearing, find that NOW Intermedia, Inc. failed, omitted, or neglected to file its 2007 and 2008 annual reports as required by Missouri statute; and authorize its General Counsel to bring a penalty action against the Company in the circuit court as provided in Section 386.600 for the statutory penalties set forth in Sections 392.210.1.

Utilities will be subject to legal action under state law for failure to submit annual reports on time without a timely extension request. A utility that does not timely file its annual report, or its response to a notice that its annual report is deficient when a response is sought, is subject to a penalty of one hundred dollars for each day that it is late in filing its annual report or response to a notice of deficiency.
