ORDER DIRECTING STAFF AND COMPANY TO REPLY TO PUBLIC COUNSEL'S RESPONSE

On March 5, 2009, Highway H Utilities, Inc. filed an application for authority to construct and operate a water system in an expanded service area in Pulaski County, Missouri. Staff filed a recommendation on May 15 advising the Commission to approve Highway H's application. On May 21, Public Counsel filed a response to Staff's recommendation in which it accepted most of Staff's recommendations. However, Public Counsel differs from Staff in that it advises the Commission to approve the rates Highway H will be allowed to charge in the expanded service area as interim rates, subject to customer refund or credit, pending the establishment of permanent rates in Highway H's ongoing small company rate increase proceeding.

Before acting on Staff's recommendation or Public Counsel's response, the Commission will direct Staff and Highway H to reply to Public Counsel's response.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- The Commission's Staff and Highway H Utilities, Inc. shall file a reply to Public Counsel's Response to Staff's Recommendation no later than June 1, 2009.
