APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL OF AN INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT

COMES NOW YMax Communications Corp., a Delaware corporation ("Applicant" or "YMax"), by its undersigned counsel, pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.060 and 4 CSR 240-3.513(1), and hereby files its Application for Approval of an Interconnection Agreement (Agreement), under the Telecommunications Act of 1996 ("1996 Act"). The Agreement is between Applicant and Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P. d/b/a AT&T Missouri (f/k/a SBC Missouri) ("ATT Missouri"). ATT Missouri's current/latest fictitious name was recognized by the Commission in Case No. IN-2006-0232.

In support of this Application, Applicant states as follows:

I. PARTIES

Applicant is a competitive telecommunications carrier authorized to provide basic local exchange telecommunications services by the Commission in Case No. CA-2006-0373, by Order issued May 25, 2006 (and effective on June 4, 2006). The nature of Applicant's business is the provision of telecommunications services. Applicant is a Delaware corporation with its principal place of business at 223 Sunset Avenue, Suite 223, Palm Beach, Florida, 33480.

Applicant's authority to transact business in Missouri from the Secretary of State's Office was filed with the Commission in the above-referenced case and is incorporated herein by reference pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.060 (1) (G).

Applicant states, in accordance with 4 CSR 240-2.060(1) (K), that there are no pending actions or final unsatisfied judgments or decisions against Applicant in any state, federal agency or court which involve customer service or rates for which action, judgment or decision has occurred within three (3) years of the date of this Application.

Pursuant to 4 CSR 240 240-2.060(1) (L), Applicant states that it does not have any overdue annual reports or assessment fees owed to the Commission.

AT&T Missouri is a Texas limited partnership with its principal offices in Missouri located at One Bell Center (which may now be called One AT&T Center), Suite 4210, Saint Louis, Missouri 63101. AT&T Missouri, a subsidiary of SBC Communications, Inc., is an incumbent local exchange carrier (ILEC) in Missouri.

II. INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT REACHED

Applicant presents to this Commission for approval an Interconnection Agreement entered into between AT&T Missouri and Applicant, executed pursuant to the terms of the 1996 Act and submitted as an interconnection agreement arrived at through negotiation pursuant to 4 CSR 240-3.513(1). This agreement is a negotiated contract and is based upon the terms of the standard AT&T 13-STATE Interconnection Agreement that AT&T Missouri has entered into with other competitive telecommunications carriers, and which has previously been approved by the Commission. There are no outstanding issues between Applicant and AT&T Missouri that need the assistance of mediation or arbitration.

III. REQUEST FOR APPROVAL

Applicant seeks the Commission's approval of the Agreement, consistent with the provisions of the 1996 Act and Missouri law. The implementation of this Agreement, complies fully with Section 252(e) of the 1996 Act because the Agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity and does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier.

IV. STANDARD OF REVIEW

The statutory standards of review are set forth in Section 252(e) of the 1996 Act which provides as follows:

(e) Approval by State Commission.

- (1) Approval required. Any interconnection agreement adopted by negotiation or arbitration shall be submitted for approval to the State Commission. A State Commission to which an agreement is submitted shall approve or reject the agreement, with written findings as to any deficiencies.
- (2) Grounds for rejection. The State may only reject:
 - (A) an agreement (or any portion thereof adopted by negotiation under subsection (a)) if it finds that:
 - (i) the agreement (or portion thereof) discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement; or
 - (ii) the implementation of such agreement or portion is not consistent with the public interest convenience, and necessity.

V. MISSOURI LAW

The executed Agreement is consistent with Missouri law.

VI. CONCLUSION

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, the Applicant respectfully requests that the Commission approve the Applicant's Interconnection Agreement with AT&T Missouri as submitted herein.
