On November 25, 2014, the Commission's Staff filed a motion asking the Commission to cancel the Eligible Telecommunications Carrier (ETC) status of ExOp of Missouri, Inc., d/b/a FairPoint Communications.<sup>1</sup> Staff's motion explains that ExOp of Missouri has contacted Staff and asked to relinquish its ETC status. This order will establish a time for the filing of a response to Staff's motion.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Anyone wishing to respond to Staff's Motion to Cancel Designation shall do so no later than December 5, 2014.
