STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and states:

- 1. The Staff recommends that the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) grant Amerivon, LLC (Applicant), a certificate of service authority to provide interexchange and local exchange telecommunications services, with the local exchange authority restricted to dedicated private line services. The Commission shall grant an application for a certificate of telecommunications service authority upon a finding that the grant of authority is in the public interest. §§392.430 and 392.440, RSMo 2000. A copy of the Staff recommendation dated December 7, 2005, is marked "Appendix A," attached hereto and made a part hereof.
- 2. Staff also recommends that the Commission classify the Applicant and its services as competitive. The Commission may classify a telecommunications provider or its services as competitive if the Commission determines it is subject to sufficient competition to justify a lesser degree of regulation. §392.361.4, RSMo 2000. All the services a competitive company provides must be classified as competitive. §392.361.3, RSMo 2000.
- 3. Staff further recommends that the Commission approve the waivers listed in the Notice of Application. The Commission may waive the application of its rules and certain

statutes if the Commission determines that waiver is consistent with the purposes of Chapter 392. §§ 392.185, 392.361.5 and 392.420, RSMo 2000.

4. Finally, Staff recommends that the Commission grant approval of the Applicant's proposed tariff, Missouri PSC Tariff No. 1, with a proposed effective date of December 23, 2005.

WHEREFORE, Staff recommends that the Commission grant Amerivon, LLC a certificate of service authority to provide interexchange and local exchange telecommunications services, with the local exchange authority restricted to dedicated private line services; grant it the requested competitive classification; grant the waivers listed in the Commission's Notice of Application; and approve its proposed tariff Missouri PSC Tariff No. 1, with a proposed effective date of December 23, 2005.

If the directly competing ILEC, in whose service area the applicant is operating, decreases its originating and/or terminating access service rates, the applicant shall file an appropriate tariff amendment to reduce its originating and/or terminating access rates in the directly competing ILEC's service area within 30 days of the directly competing ILEC's reduction of its originating and/or terminating access rates in order to maintain the cap.
