On March 15, 2007, United American Technology, Inc. ("UAT") applied to the Missouri Public Service Commission for a certificate of service authority to provide interexchange and nonswitched local exchange telecommunications services in Missouri. In conjunction with its application, UAT also filed a tariff, which the Commission considers to be an illustrative tariff since it bears neither an issue date nor an effective date. On March 20, 2007, the Commission issued notice of the application and established April 4, 2007 as the deadline for submission of requests to intervene.
