On November 4, 2020, the Commission granted Staff's request to increase the MoUSF support amount for Lifeline voice-only service from \$16.75 to \$18.75 if the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) continues with its plan to reduce support by \$2.00 on December 1, 2020. On November 19, 2020, Staff notified the Commission that the FCC's Wireline Competition Bureau issued an order on November 16, 2020 denying a petition to waive the scheduled reduction for support for stand-alone Lifeline voice service.

This means that on December 1, 2020, the federal support for Lifeline voice-only service will be decreased by \$2.00. Thus, the Commission issues this notice to state that due to the FCC's November 16, 2020 action, the MoUSF support amount for Lifeline voice-only service will increase from \$16.75 to \$18.75 on December 1, 2020.
