ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE AND ACCOMPANYING TARIFF

Issue Date: January 18, 2011

Effective Date: January 28, 2011

On December 29, 2010, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting Consumer Access's ("Consumer Access") certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff to provide interexchange telecommunications services in the State of Missouri be cancelled.

In File Number TA-97-51, the Commission granted Consumer Access a certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunications service in the State of Missouri. The Company's tariff, P.S.C. Mo No. 1, was also approved.

Staff states in its motion that Consumer Access has reported no jurisdictional revenue in annual reports for the years 2008 and 2009. Staff notes that it is not in the public interest to allow telecommunication companies to retain their certificates of service authority if they have not conducted business in Missouri for over a year. Staff recommends that the Commission cancel the company's certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services, and the company's accompanying tariff.

On December 30, 2010, the Commission issued an Order Directing Notice allowing any parties to file an objection or request a hearing to do so no later than January 10, 2011. No objections or requests for a hearing were filed.

The Commission has the authority to cancel a certificate and tariff pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo, which states, in part, “[a]ny certificate or service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected.”

Based on Staff’s motion, the Commission finds that the certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff granted to Consumer Access shall be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The certificate of authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services granted to Consumer Access, in File Number TA-97-51, is canceled.
2. Consumer Access’s tariff, P.S.C. Mo No. 1, is canceled.
3. This order shall become effective on January 28, 2011.
4. This case may be closed on January 29, 2011.
