WITHDRAWAL OF STAFF MOTION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and states as follows:

1. On December 30, 2010, the Staff filed a Motion to Cancel the certificate of service authority granted on March 26, 2007, to Mobilitie, LLC (“the Company”), because it reported no Missouri jurisdictional revenue for the past two years. Staff’s motivation for its filing was not to be punitive, but to merely remove those telecommunications companies not actively involved in providing services in Missouri to better maintain the Commission’s records.

2. On February 22, 2011, the Staff received the attached e-mail, in which the company indicates that it needs to maintain its Missouri certification to work with wireless providers to replace certain cell towers. The Staff’s Motion, if granted, could interfere with those efforts, which the Staff views as an undesirable result.

3. The Staff, although it is withdrawing its Motion, will continue to examine ways in which such companies can be assessed some portion of the PSC’s operating expenses, so that they do not unfairly burden the ratepayers of other telecommunications carriers.

WHEREFORE, Staff withdraws its Motion to cancel the Certificate of Service Authority and tariff for Mobilitie, LLC and asks that this matter be closed without further Commission action.

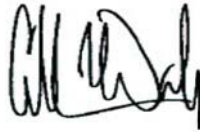

Colleen --

As you may know, the Commission has indicated that Mobilitie, LLC's certificate of operating authority may be cancelled owing to lack of Missouri revenues (latest order attached). The purpose of this email is to verify that Mobilitie is working to assist at least two wireless carriers with identifying solutions to replace existing tower sites in Missouri which are currently uneconomic. The project could involve as many as 200 sites in Missouri, some of which are in the public right-of-way. To occupy the right-of-way it is likely Mobilitie will need proof of certification from the Commission.

I would appreciate the opportunity to discuss a withdrawal of Staff's motion based on the above information. Would there be a convenient time this week for you or a colleague to chat?
