**MOTION TO CANCEL CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY  
AND ASSOCIATED TARIFF**

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, by and through the undersigned counsel, and moves for the Commission to cancel the certificate of service authority of Reunion Communications, Inc., ("Reunion Communications" or "Company") and associated tariff. For its Motion, Staff respectfully states as follows:

1. On February 16, 2011, the Commission issued an order granting a certificate of service authority to the Company to provide interexchange telecommunications services in the state of Missouri in Case No. XA-2011-0234, tariff tracking no. YX-2011-0352.

2. On December 31, 2013, the Commission received a letter from Reunion Communications stating that the Company is in the process of withdrawing its corporate registration with Missouri. (BCES-2014-0406) (See Attachment A).

3. Because Reunion Communications is withdrawing its corporate registration and ceasing its operations in Missouri, Staff recommends the Commission cancel its certificate of service authority.

4. The Commission has the authority to cancel a telecommunications certificate pursuant to Section 392.410.5 RSMo 2000, which provides “[a]ny certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected.”

5. The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing. *State ex rel. Rex Deffenderfer Enterprises, Inc. v. Public Service Commission*, 776 S.W.2d 494 (Mo. App. W.D. 1989).

6. Reunion Communications is current on the filing of its annual reports and the remittance of Commission assessments and Missouri Universal Service Fund surcharges. However, because the Company was certificated throughout 2013, the Company will still be responsible for the filing of its calendar year 2013 annual report.

**WHEREFORE**, Staff recommends the Commission cancel the certificate of service authority and associated tariff of Reunion Communications, Inc., to provide interexchange telecommunications services in the state of Missouri.
