On May 27, 2005, Mr. Thompson filed a Request for Admission as Visiting Attorney. Mr. Thompson is not admitted to the Missouri Bar, but requests to appear *pro hac vice* under Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.040(3)(C). Mr. Thompson is a member in good standing of the bar of the District of Columbia. The movant designated Jason L. Ross to serve as local counsel for NextG. Mr. Ross is a member of the Missouri Bar. On June 15, 2005, Mr. Thompson provided proof of his compliance with Missouri Supreme Court Rule 6.01(m).

The Commission finds that the request to appear is in compliance with the Commission's rule and has complied with Rule 6.01(m). Therefore, the Commission determines that Mr. Thompson should be granted leave to appear.
