ORDER GRANTING LEAVE TO APPEAR

This order grants John Dodge leave to appear as visiting counsel for Mobilitie, LLC ("Mobilitie") in this matter.

On March 2, 2007, John Dodge of the Washington, DC law firm of Davis Wright Tremaine LLP filed a Request for Admission as Visiting Attorney appearing on behalf of Mobilitie under Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.040(3)(C).

The request indicates that Mr. Dodge is a member in good standing of the Bar of the District of Columbia, and that he has not been disqualified to appear in any court. The request also recites that Jason L. Ross, who is a member of the Missouri Bar and is affiliated with the St. Louis, Missouri law firm of Greensfelder, Hemker & Gale, P.C., has already entered his appearance for Mobilitie in this case and that Mr. Dodge has designated Mr. Ross to serve as associate counsel for purposes of this case.

Mr. Dodge has also submitted a February 27, 2007 letter from the Clerk of the Missouri Supreme Court showing Mr. Dodge's compliance with Missouri Supreme Court Rule 6.01(m) with regard to this case.

The Commission finds that Mr. Dodge has substantially complied with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.040(3)(C) and Missouri Supreme Court Rules 6.01(m) and 9.03. Accordingly, his request for leave to appear and participate in this case on behalf of Mobilitie as a visiting attorney is granted.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. John Dodge's request for leave to appear and participate in Case No. XA-2007-0299 as a visiting attorney under Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.040(3)(C) is granted.
2. This order shall become effective on March 5, 2007.
